PyeongChang is known for its majestic mountains located approximately 180 Km east of Seoul in the Northern part of South Korea in Gangwon.

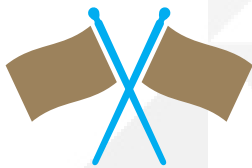

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT REQUESTING EVENT TICKETS

Requesting event tickets for the Olympic Games is far more complex than purchasing tickets for any other sporting event. However, if you read the following information before submitting your ticket request, you will be able to complete your online ticket order with the minimum of complications. Cartan Global utilizes this method for "Ticket Only Purchasing." Clients selecting one of Cartan's Travel Programs are not required to complete an Online Ticket Order. The dedicated Account Manager will assist with any ticketing needs.

TICKET CODES

Each ticket is sold for a single session, date, location and price. There are up to four price categories per session. Each ticket gives access to everything listed within that session in the Event Schedule. Each ticket is represented by its own TICKET CODE.

For Example:

SJP01A (i.e. the ticket code)

SJP: Ski Jumping (the sport abbreviation)

01: The first session of the sport

A: Top price category

*Where there is only one price category for tickets, these are all coded "A."

PLEASE NOTE that dates and times are given for the events are based on the most up-to-date information available but are subject to change in response to alterations to the program made by PyeongChang 2018™. Cartan will do their best to keep you updated on any changes that might affect your choice of tickets.

TICKET PRICES

The SELLING PRICES shown in Cartan's PyeongChang 2018™ Ticket Brochure are in U.S. dollars and include all IOC and PyeongChang 2018™ approved handling fees and currency conversions. Additionally, all ticket prices include a 20% handling fee which is capped at KWN (Korean Won) 100,000 per ticket.

All of Cartan's ticket prices were established and approved at an IOC/PyeongChang 2018™ fixed conversion rate of 1 U.S. Dollar = .00009769 against the KWN face value for each ticket which are also listed as a matter of reference within the Ticket Brochure.

Although currency rates change from time to time, this same rate will be applicable for all ticket prices unless extreme fluctuation occurs between the USD and KWN as determined by Cartan and subsequently approved by the IOC and PyeongChang 2018™.

Additionally, Cartan has provided a COMPARATIVE PRICING LIST which shows the ticket prices in each country's local currency. However, all of Cartan's tickets are sold in US Dollars.

CEREMONY TICKETS

The Opening and Closing Ceremonies of any Olympic Games are the focal point of great interest and anticipation.

With a worldwide audience of billions to be watching the ceremonies "live" on television, the demand for the tickets is always insatiable. While Cartan has secured an initial allocation of tickets for both ceremonies and will continue to try to secure more, the overall number of tickets that Cartan will receive is likely to be very small in comparison to the demand. In addition, historically the tickets that are allocated to Authorized Ticket Resellers are in the higher price categories. This is likely to be a pattern that will continue as Cartan secures more in the future.

TICKET ARRANGEMENTS FOR SPECTATORS WITH DISABILITIES

All venues will have designated disabled seating. However, the number of spaces will vary from venue to venue. In addition, most official transportation vehicles are expected to be designated to be accessible to spectators with different types of special needs. It should be noted; however, that it might not be possible to get to the gates of every venue on the transportation system, so some walking may still be required.

If you are a wheelchair user, limited in your mobility or suffering from visual impairment, please ensure that you detail your requirements so that we can relay this information to PyeongChang 2018™ in advance. Please note, however, that seating for “companions” in the designated disabled areas will usually be restricted to one seat, so larger parties including a disabled spectator may not be able to be seated together

Please email info@cartan.com to request handicap accessible seating. These tickets need to be requested on an as needed basis from PyeongChang 2018 and are not guaranteed until confirmed by PyeongChang 2018

PARENTS AND FAMILIES OF SPECTATORS

PyeongChang 2018™ is aiming to deliver a service that gives each athletes the opportunity to purchase one or two tickets for almost every session in which they are competing. The sale and distribution of these tickets will be done through each country’s National Olympic Committee beginning February 2017. If you are traveling to PyeongChang 2018™ to see a close family relative compete please contact your country’s NOC for information on athlete and family tickets. Should you require more than the one or two tickets allocated to this program, it is recommended that you request them from Cartan Global is they are available.

RESERVED SEATING & GENERAL ADMISSION VENUES

As in previous Olympic Games, detailed information is not yet available regarding venue plans. This includes the allocation of seat/standing areas at the venues to the specific price category, or which actual seat areas will be allocated to us at any of the events. These details will only be advised to us shortly before the start of the Games, so no notification of seat locations or other stadium information can be given out prior to the actual distribution of tickets.

In addition, as PyeongChang 2018™ has not yet published details of their policy for allocating block of seats, Cartan cannot undertake to seat groups or large parties together, although we will obviously do our best to do so.

There are a number of venues which will be designated as “general admission” – i.e. a ticket is required for entry, but there is no reserved seating, or there will be “general admission by price category” i.e. with different sections designated for different prices categories but no reserved seating within sections.

Specifically any tickets in the B category for outdoor venues (i.e. Biathlon, Bobsled, Luge, Skiing, Snowboarding) are considered General Admission tickets for the Winter Games. These tickets may be sitting or standing only tickets depending on the venue.

TRANSPORTATION

The majority of spectators are expected to travel within PyeongChang 2018™ by public transportation. For more information regarding PyeongChang’s public transportation, visit PyeongChang 2018’s Website (www.pyeongchang2018.com).

EVENT TICKET ONLY CLIENTS

Clients will receive officially printed material detailing the public transport services for PyeongChang 2018™ period and this will accompany the event tickets when they are distributed. Clients who purchase Cartan’s Travel Package will receive updates giving details of the progress of the official transportation plans and other information that might be of use in their Olympic Games preparation.

DISTRIBUTION OF EVENT TICKETS

The event tickets will NOT be able to be delivered to clients before their departure for PyeongChang. Event tickets will be distributed from Cartan’s onsite ticket center in PyeongChang which will open a few days before the Opening Ceremony and will remain open throughout PyeongChang 2018™. Full details of the distribution arrangements for tickets will be published approximately three months before the start of PyeongChang 2018™. Please be aware that all ticket orders will include a minimal delivery fee as follows:
